

Smile for a Lifetime of Greater Raleigh Area

Applicant Criteria

- 1. Family income of no more than 185% of the federal poverty level but not qualified for Medicaid. (In general, if the applicant qualifies for the free or reduced-price school lunch program in North Carolina, he or she will meet the financial qualifications of Smile for a Lifetime of Greater Raleigh.)
- 2. Must have a significant aesthetic need for braces.
- 3. Must be between 8 and 18 years old.
- 4. Must be a currently enrolled student
- 5. Must agree to follow the treatment plan, must agree and be willing to make **morning** appointments, and demonstrate the ability and commitment to make all appointments on time
- 6. Must have two positive recommendations from teachers or community leaders that specifically support the following qualities of the applicant: (a) good attitude; (b) leadership/involvement; (c) work ethics and (d) character.
- 7. Must be involved in community service, and be willing during the treatment period to develop and pursue a Service Plan to "pay it forward" to help other young people.
- 8. Must be committed maintaining excellent oral hygiene (brushing & flossing).
