SMILE FOR A LIFETIME

Applicant Criteria

1. Must have family income of no more than 185% of the federal poverty level but not qualified for Medicaid. (In general, if the applicant qualifies for the free or reduced-price school lunch program in North Carolina, he or she will meet the financial qualifications of Smile For A Lifetime.)
2. Must have a significant aesthetic or functional need for braces.
3. Must be between ages of 8 and 18 years old.
4. Must be currently enrolled as a full time student.
5. Must have two positive recommendations from teachers or community leaders that specifically support the following qualities of the applicant:
 - a. good attitude,
 - b. leadership/involvement,
 - c. work ethic, and
 - d. character.
6. Must have Dental Clearance Form completed by a dental professional stating eligibility for orthodontic treatment.
7. Must consent to social media release agreement.
8. Must be committed to maintaining excellent oral hygiene (brushing & flossing), including regular visits to a dental provider during treatment.
9. Must agree to follow the treatment plan, be willing to make morning appointments, and demonstrate the ability and commitment to make all appointments on time.
10. Must be involved in regular community service for the entire duration of the orthodontic treatment period.
